**Old Business:**

Web Master Contract: One minor change to contract. It was to have the date of service changed to match the E-Boards budget year. Motion to approve, motion passed.

2005 E-Board Nom: Legislative – Cheryl declined nomination, NWS nominated Dan Harper, he accepted. NE Region Mike Ryan/Rick Olsen nominated as Co-coordinators both accepted. Mad Max is now running alone.

Budget: 2 possible proposals will be sent to BOD reps after September E-Board meeting. Vote in October.

DNR Rep Appointment: Terry Hopkins

**New Business:**

Budget proposal to be submitted in April – Liberty chapter motioned to move up budget proposal to give chapters more time to review. However, per the by-laws, budget must be approved no later than two months after proposal is sent out, unless by-law is changed. Liberty withdrew their motion.
